


INVITING THE SAN DIEGO EMMAUS COMMUNITY TO GATHER TOGETHER!

Message from the Assistant Community Spiritual Director - The Joy of Gathering

As I write this I am exhausted and moving slowly through the current day. Today is Tuesday afternoon and just last Sunday I finished serving as the Camp Pastor for Elementary Summer Camp at Camp Cedar Glen. If you know Camp Cedar Glen you know it was carved into the side of the mountain in Julian and I walked up and down those hills so many times last week, I am exhausted. Elementary campers are notorious for late nights and early mornings. They are so excited they can hardly sleep, which means those of us running the camp also don't get much sleep. I am exhausted. The sleep I did get was in a rustic bunk bed, not my idea of luxury – for so many reasons I am exhausted.

And, for so many reasons I would do it all over again right now if I could. My body is exhausted and it will probably take me a week or so to feel right again. My spirit could not be more alive and full than it is right now. I witnessed kids finding God's love for the first time, kids welcoming one another and making new friends in Christ, teenagers giving of their time to serve as counselors, and so much more. I sat back and witnessed the Kingdom of God come alive right before my eyes. At that gathering up in the mountains the presence of God and the work of the Holy Spirit was evident and palpable. This is why I so love Summer Camp.

This is also why I love the Emmaus Community. On the Walks or Chrysalis or Face to Face, when we gather, it gives us a chance to see the evidence of God at work in our lives. Of course, God is always at work in our lives, but alone we too often miss it. When we are together with others it just seems easier to witness the work of God in us and through us. An important aspect of the Emmaus Community is just that; we are a community, a group of people meant to gather. It might be a weekend retreat like a Walk, it might be a regular grouping, it might be an occasional Gathering like we have coming up soon – all opportunities for us to witness the work of God in one another. I do hope you will prayerfully consider sponsoring someone in our next round of Walks so they too can experience the work of God in our community. I hope you will consider serving on the team for our next round of Walks and I hope you will make the time to join us at the Gathering that is coming up. Let us gather together, exhausted or not, and have our spirits refreshed by the goodness of God.

Face2Face #7 Reboot

As you may know, Face2Face #7 was interrupted last year after the first weekend due to the COVID pandemic. With so much time having passed, we are going to start the encounter again from the beginning. The new dates are March 4,5, 11, 12, 2022. The encounter will be held at Rancho Bernardo Community Church (aka Rancho Bernardo Community Presbyterian Church).



A little background on Face to Face. Face to Face is a version of Walk to Emmaus that is designed for Pilgrims age 60 and over. Rather than going for a 72 hour retreat, the Pilgrims experience the encounter on two consecutive weekends (Friday and Saturday during the day), and they do not stay overnight. Men and women attend together, but have separate tables (i.e. men's tables led by male table leaders and women's tables led by female table leaders).

Here are ways you can help these Pilgrims experience the love within the body of Christ.

Pray. Pray for the Encounter, the Team, the Pilgrims. Pray about whom you might invite.

Team. Many of the team members are available to serve on the reboot, but a few are not. If you feel called to serve on the team, please contact me (or say "yes" when I contact you).

Invite/Promote. There are no sponsors for F2F. The team will take care of communicating with Pilgrims and gathering agape, but we still need the community members making prospective Pilgrims aware of the encounter and what Walk to Emmaus or Face2Face has meant in their lives. Applications are available on the website.

Attend Candlelight and/or Closing. Candlelight happens in the middle of the afternoon on the 2nd Friday of the encounter. This sometimes makes it harder to get the level of attendance that we do for candlelight on Walk to Emmaus, as some people are at work at that time. If you are available, plan on attending Candlelight on Friday, March 11 and Closing on Saturday, March 12.

Agape. Your gifts of agape can bless the Pilgrims. Write agape. Provide table agape. Donate food agape.


